To qualify for scholarship eligibility the applicant must have the following qualifications:

- ❖ Applicant must be the primary member on account and in good standing.
- ❖ Applicant must be graduating from high school in 2017 or have graduated from high school within the past three years.
- ❖ Applicant must be planning to pursue an undergraduate education at least part time.
- ❖ Applicant must complete the scholarship application and essay by the given deadline.

Please complete the following scholarship package for consideration:

A completed application form along with an essay of 500 words or less, typed and double-spaced, in response to the following question, “Why should you be selected for this scholarship? Please describe any academic achievements, community service activities, examples of leadership, or other personal characteristics that make you deserving of this scholarship.” Essays will be judged on grammar, originality, attention to detail and specific examples.

Deadline for entry...

In order to be considered for the scholarship, applicants must ensure that the completed scholarship package is received or postmarked to UTFCU by Friday, March 10, 2017. **(Faxed or e-mailed materials will NOT be accepted!)** The scholarships will be awarded at our Annual Meeting on Friday, April 21, 2017.

How do I apply?
